

Unitarian Universalist Women's Federation (UUWF) Board is seeking a new VP for Recruitment & Outreach!

From the Bylaws: The Vice President/ Recruitment and Outreach shall be responsible for recruitment of women for volunteer positions on the board, funding panels, and other committees and task forces. Keeping in mind UUWF's goal of diversity in leadership, and in support of recruitment efforts, she shall reach out to UU groups and organizations that can aid in recruitment – such as women's groups in local congregations, district/regional staff, and UUA staff – and build strategic relationships with them. She shall perform such duties and have such powers additional to the foregoing as the Trustees shall designate.

Specific duties: Coordinate UUWF presence at General Assembly. In 2017-2018, the VP / Recruitment and Outreach will form a Nominating Committee, which will assist the VP / Recruitment and Outreach with recruitment efforts.

From the Bylaws: Trustees will have distinct portfolios with specific responsibilities. In addition, the Trustees together have the following shared responsibilities:

- attend and actively participate in regularly scheduled Board meetings;
- plan for General Assembly;
- collaborate in budget development and implementation;
- collaborate on recruitment of Board and panel members and other volunteers;
- assume responsibilities for fundraising strategies and activities;
- serve as ambassadors for the vision and mission of the UUWF to congregations, districts and the wider movement;
- utilize social networking and other new technologies when possible to facilitate Board business.

We are seeking candidates who have the ability to travel to Board meetings three times per year (including General Assembly). The next meeting is at the end of October in Boston, MA. Other qualities we are looking for in our next VP / Recruitment and Outreach include: strong organizational skills, understanding of General Assembly, connected or willing to build connections across our UU movement.

We are seeking candidates who are able to commit to at least a four-year term.
