She has been elected to the All Souls Deacons and served as its Secretary. Peggy was a Small Group Ministry Co-Facilitator for three years and is a Lay Pastoral Associate. She is also currently a Capital Campaign Visitor.

As a longstanding volunteer at the UU United Nations Office, she has served as a Board member and as its President and now continue as All Souls Envoy.
