Ann Stebbins was a UU in Minneapolis, Minnesota, and then in Lexington, Kentucky prior to becoming a member of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Madison County (UUPMC) in Richmond, Kentucky. In fact, Ann and her husband, Bob, were part of a group of fourteen people who began thinking about establishing a UU in our area in about 1965. and succeeded in having our Fellowship officially recognized by the UUA in 1978.
